Support Offered To Grieving Children

We are pleased to advertise an outstanding support for grieving children. Camp Sunrise is a grief support camp for bereaved youth ages 7-14 offered through Hospice of Redmond. It will take place at Suttle Lake, west of Sisters, on June 20-22nd. Camp Sunrise is founded on the understanding that every child deserves the opportunity to grieve in a safe, supportive and understanding environment. This supportive program allows students to share their experience and acceptance as they move through the healing process. Parents/guardians are required to attend an interview and orientation. Support for parents and guardians and an adult grief support group is available to enhance the grieving child's journey through the healing process. 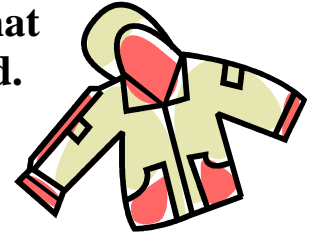
