## Kids Medical Clinic Open This Summer

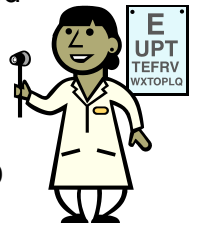
The Kids Clinic located at Crooked River Elementary is pleased to announce that they will be open during the summer for your child's medical needs.
