



**** NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL OPENS SEPTEMBER 2015 – BARNES BUTTE ELEMENTARY;**

**** ELEMENTARY BOUNDARY LINES WILL BE CHANGING TO ACCOMMODATE STUDENT CAPACITY;**

**** CCSD IS LOOKING FOR CONSTRUCTIVE PARENT/COMMUNITY INPUT.**

In order to improve educational opportunity and efficient operation, Crook County School District is moving from our current three-school model to a two-school model. Barnes Butte Elementary will open in the fall of 2015 with a 700 student capacity and a newly remodeled Cecil Sly Elementary will open in the fall of 2016 with a 700 student capacity. Ochoco Elementary will be closing at the end of the current school year. During the 2015-2016 school year, Cecil Sly Elementary School students will be served at Crooked River Elementary while Cecil Sly is remodeled.

This elementary boundary proposal is based upon October 1st enrollment data and projects proposed boundaries for Barnes Butte Elementary and Cecil Sly Elementary.

Proposed Enrollment for fall of 2015:

Barnes Butte – 603 Students (Capacity 700)

Cecil Sly Students served at Crooked River – 562 Students (Capacity 575)

The proposal provides for future growth for both schools while operating at near capacity in the 2015-2016 year that Cecil Sly students are served at Crooked River.
