SLP Referral Process

- 1) All communication concerns and referrals for students who are not yet eligible for special education go through the CARE team process and are documented with the CARE coordinator.
- 2) Referring party informs SLP of concerns. If SLP determines that a CARE referral is needed, teachers contact parents and fill out CARE team referral form.
- 3) The child is presented at CARE team. The team decides whether a screening is needed (written parent permission is required). If there is sufficient data the team may also choose to pursue RTI/Speech Improvement (written parent permission required) or move to a SET team meeting.
- 4) If the team refers the child for special education evaluation, parents are contacted and the SPED referral form is completed by the SLP. A speech and language case history is given to guardians to complete at (or prior to) the SET meeting.
