
Setting Up Android for Exchange

Follow these steps to set an Android device to access your **Crook County School Exchange e-mail account**. These instructions and images are from a Samsung phone. Your device may not look or have the same options.

1. Set up an e-mail account using Mail.

Open Settings, then Accounts, and scroll down to the bottom and Add Account. Then Select Microsoft Exchange Activesync or corporate email.




2. Enter your account information.

Enter your Crook County School District e-mail address in the Email field.

Enter your Crook County School District password in the Password field.

Click Next or Manual Setup.



3. Enter your Exchange information.


Enter ccs in the Domain\username field as shown in the image. ccs\username

Your username is the same as your computer login. It is either first.lastname or lastnamefirstinitial. For example, it would be either John.Doe or Doej. Enter your username in the Username field.


Your password should already be entered into the password field. If not, then enter your password in the password field.

Enter ccsd02.crookcounty.k12.or.us in the Server field.


Click Next.




4. Select OK on the Remote security administration



5. Specify period to sync and other sync options. 3 days to 1 week should be sufficient. Select Next.



6. Select Activate to Activate the phone administrator.
