- **1.1.** Increase the use of assessment and accountability data to inform instructional decisions. The goal was reviewed and rated **+**.
- 1.2 Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding the state reading standard by the end of the 3rd grade.

1.3 Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding the state reading standard by the end of the 3rd grade.
