New Business

Leland gave a brief overview presentation of a power point that will be used in the future for safety training. The power point is the Standard Response Protocol for Students and Teachers. The hope is that all Tri-County schools will use the same protocol and be able to share emergency resources if needed, with all emergency personnel being familiar with the system. The SRPST program consists of four parts: Lockout, Lockdown, Evacuate, Shelter. It outlines how to identify which type of danger is occurring and what the proper protocol is to handle the situation.

It was mentioned that it would be a good idea to check all intercoms in all schools. This would be a good summer project.

Leland mentioned the need for electronic gates at the back of the High School.

It was brought up and discussed that Pioneer is in need of an intercom system and new locks.
