Leland said that the newer buildings lock down to prevent passage, and they have worked on Pioneer to improve for less visibility because the windows are old and easier to see in.

Leland said if OSHA shows up, contact him immediately. Next notice for inspection is April 10

Leland said that he is meeting next week with Police to talk about standard response protocol. Ramona recommended having the committee go through the actual active shooter training, as it gives a different perspective.
