Dear CCSD Staff,

In compliance with the E.P.A. regulation "Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act," all school buildings are inspected for asbestos containing materials. A management plan was developed and completed for all buildings containing asbestos materials.

Some materials were found to contain asbestos in some school buildings. The AHERA Management Plan identifies, locates and states how these materials will be managed.

In addition, all school buildings will be inspected as a part of the mandated three-year Federal re-inspection program in 2020.

All asbestos containing materials are sealed, enclosed or maintained in a manner to prevent release of asbestos fiber into the air. Asbestos containing material controlled this way does not present a health hazard to students or staff.

The Crook County AHERA Management Plan may be inspected at the School District Facilities Department Office during regular office hours.
